<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● <b>Cyanobacteria algae</b> has been detected the past two summers; which can harm humans and pets.</li><li>● Our water quality sampling program has indicated that <b>phosphorus</b>, which feeds algae blooms, has seen <b>elevated levels</b> the past five years.</li><li>● NHDES has determined our lake is <b>impaired for dissolved oxygen</b>, which negatively impacts aquatic life.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● A Watershed-based Plan would provide science-based identification of environmental challenges in the watershed<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Required by NHDES in order to apply for grant funding for watershed improvement projects</li><li>○ sources, causes, and possible solutions to address lake degradation</li></ul></li></ul>
